

Century City Ski Club hiking Towsley Canyon

Meet: 10:00 am, Sunday, May 2, 2021

Leave: 10:15 am

Where: Towsley Canyon – located at 24255 The Old Road, Newhall.

Directions: If you are headed north on the 5 Freeway get off at the Calgrove exit. Turn left and go west under freeway ½ mile to the entrance. Turn right and go to parking lot on the right after you drive through the gate.

Description: This is the time of the year when the California poppies should be in bloom. The hike should take between 2 and 3 hours depending on what happened the night before. This will include a gradual climb of about 1500 vertical feet along a 5.5 mile loop from the parking lot. We will be going through “The Narrows of Towsley Canyon” which has some interesting geologic formations and we will also pass an oil pond bubbling out of the ground.

What to Bring: About 2 quarts of water, a snack, hiking shoes, sunscreen, a hat, ski pole (will help you walk down hill), and a good attitude.

Restaurant: Afterwards we will be going to a local restaurant.

If it rains or there is a fire, the hike is canceled.
